#### Home Care Cleaner

Home Care Cleaners provide cleaning support to older Tasmanians to assist them to comfortably live in their own homes and support their independence and wellbeing.

Shifts are typically offered between 9am and 3pm, Tuesday to Friday. Perfect for those looking for daytime work during school hours.

This position is best suited to people entering the workforce or experienced cleaners with a passion for helping others.

You can work as a Home Care Cleaner while completing your Home Care Worker qualifications.



#### Home Care Worker

Home Care Workers provide direct care and support assistance to older Tasmanians living in their own home. They provide a wide range of services to enable people to live at home and stay connected to their community.

Shifts are typically offered from 7am - 5pm Monday to Friday. Perfect for those looking for daytime work with weekends off.

This position requires people who have a Certificate III in Individual Support (or equivalent).

#### **Disability Support Worker**

Disability Support Workers are vital part of people's lives. They assist clients with movement, domestic duties, mealtime support, medication administration and support with personal care.

A wide range of shifts are available including early mornings, day shifts, afternoon shifts, night shifts and sleepovers.

This position requires people who have a Certificate III in Individual Support (or equivalent), or who are currently enrolled in a course and have completed 4-5 units.

### **Application requirements**

### When applying for a job at Anglicare, you should provide

#### **☑** Resume

This is very important. It provides a snapshot of your career and should detail your current contact information, qualifications, education and training, employment history and skills.

#### Cover letter

You can be confident that you are entering a stable industry in which outstanding disability and home care support workers area always in demand.

#### Before you can start

There are some compulsory preemployment items you have to obtain before you can work with Anglicare. If you already have them it will help you start faster.

- Schedule 1 National Police Check (issued within the last 12 months).
- Tasmanian Working with Vulnerable People registration (this can take up to 21 days).
- A full or provisional Australian Drivers Licence.
- Current proof of work rights/visa.
- COVID vaccination.

### Other good things to have

- A current first aid certificate is not compulsory but can make the difference in getting you started on shifts quickly.
- Holding your manual handling certification is an excellent head start.
- Medication administration certificate.
