

Contractors (Work, Health and Safety)

Purpose

Anglicare Tasmania Inc. (“Anglicare”) is committed to preventing injury and illness by providing a safe and healthy working environment which is, as far as is reasonably practicable, without risk to personal health or safety.

Anglicare requires all contractors performing work on Anglicare sites to observe all safety regulations, as required by law, and Anglicare’s Work Health and Safety policies.

A copy of this policy will be provided to all contractors before they begin work at any Anglicare site to ensure as far as is reasonably practicable that any works conducted by a contractor are performed in a manner that does not risk the health and safety of the contractor, employees, clients or other persons (‘Workers’).

Principles

- Contractors must have their own health and safety policies covering the work and services provided to Anglicare.
- Contractors will be given access to Anglicare policies and procedures which must be complied with at all times when at Anglicare premises.
- The Contractor will ensure that all their employees, sub-contractors and agents are properly trained to competently undertake the work or services provided to Anglicare in particular in regard to the health and safety issues concerning the work or services.
- The Contractor will ensure all equipment, products, structures or plant are safe and do not represent a hazard or risk to personal health or safety.
- The Contractor will ensure that all working systems are safe and do not represent a hazard or risk to health and safety.
- The Contractor will ensure that it has a process for the reporting to Anglicare any incidents, accidents or near misses which occur during the course of any work or services provided to Anglicare.
- The Contractor will ensure compliance with all Government and other regulatory bodies’ requirements, checks and permits for the work undertaken or the services provided to Anglicare.
- The Contractor will ensure that work undertaken or services provided to Anglicare do not cause a hazard or risk to any person’s health and safety. It will undertake all appropriate and necessary risk assessments for this purpose.
- The Contractor must ensure that workers’ compensation/accident insurance, public liability and where appropriate professional indemnity insurances are in place to cover the work undertaken or services provided to Anglicare.
- The Contractor will provide their name and WWVP registration number on the sign in form at all applicable sites.
